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FULL RECONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY ROAD 4023 TO BEGIN SOON

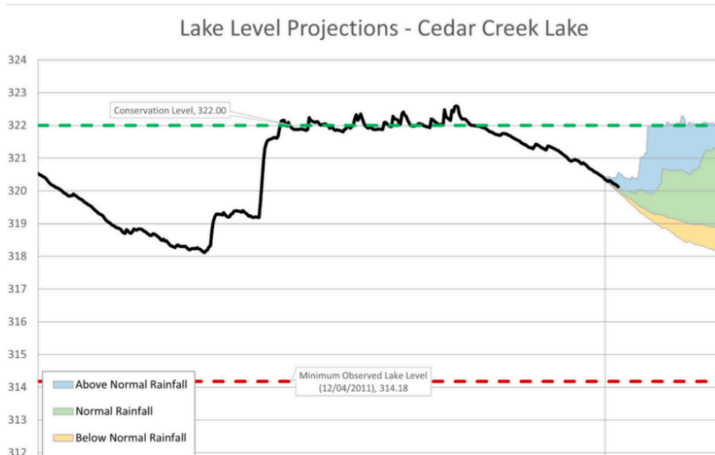
We're pleased to share great news from Precinct 4 Commissioner Tommy Moore's office. The recent gravel work on CR 4023 was just the start! A complete road reconstruction project is now scheduled to begin within the next two weeks. This long-awaited improvement will provide a smoother, safer route for residents traveling between Beacon Hill and Highway 274 in Kemp, eliminating the need to rely solely on Highway 175. advocate for these repairs. Your efforts helped bring long-term infrastructure improvements to our community's back entrance.

MUCH NEEDED RAINFALL COMING

As Lake Levels are approaching 3 feet below full pool, we are delighted to see the High Pressure Dome that has been blocking any rainfall for the last 2 months finally exit North Texas. This unusual delay in fall rains is finally over, according to the latest NOAA forecast models. There is a flood watch for our area Friday into Saturday with the potential for 5 inches of much needed rain.



BRIDGE UPGRADE ON HIGHWAY 334

TX DOT has just released their plan to complete the raising of the Seven Points/Gun Barrel City Causeway Bridge to allow pedestrian and bike lanes as well as taller boat access to our side of the Lake. The project will also boost recreation and local commerce for communities along the lake.
